

# EMERGENCY RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

FOR UNION AND SNYDER COUNTY RENTERS



Union & Snyder counties received **\$9.84 million** for direct emergency rental assistance.

Union-Snyder Community Action Agency (CAA) is now processing applications to distribute this emergency funding for eligible residents.

Union and Snyder counties are offering financial assistance to residents with unpaid **rent** or **utility** bills due to the impact of **COVID-19**.

## Eligibility Requirements Include:

- Eligible expenses include rent, utility, and other costs related to housing.
- Eligibility criteria include reduction of income or financial hardships directly or indirectly related to COVID-19 and those who were financially impacted by the public health emergency.
